

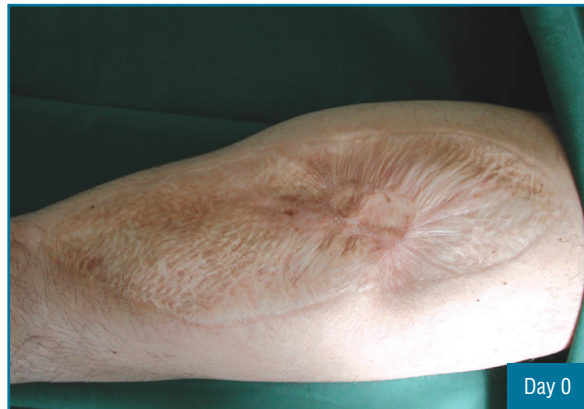
The Netherlands Experiment

History

A resident at a university hospital in the Netherlands used ABRA Adhesive Anchors to test our thesis that a fasciotomy should always be capable of being closed by re-approximating original wound margins.

This patient complained of pain caused by a twelve-year-old skin graft that had attached to his leg muscle. Four days after applying ABRA Adhesive Anchors, the original wound edges had almost re-approximated without having to surgically free them from the edges of the graft.

After excision of the original grafted skin, primary closure was achieved on most of the wound, requiring only a small skin graft.
